**Mission Offering** – Our 4<sup>th</sup> quarter mission project will be for East Fork Lutheran High School in Arizona. A little bit about the mission... the first WELS world mission field was established in 1893 on the Apache reservation in eastern Arizona. Now, in 2018, we are celebrating the 125<sup>th</sup> anniversary of this mission field. Much has changed over the years. Hundreds of missionaries and parochial teachers have come and gone. Yet, God's Word remains. Now, on any given Sunday, more than one thousand Apaches are worshipping Jesus among nine reservation churches. Our 4<sup>th</sup> quarter mission project is one of the reservation missions--East Fork Lutheran Church and School. The work is hard, the obstacles are many. Reservation statistics show 80 percent unemployment, 47 percent poverty rate, 50 percent high school dropout rate, substance abuse, and violence. In spite of challenges, the Apache Lutherans and their leaders are intensifying their efforts to heal broken homes and hearts with the saving message of the gospel.
